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
Environmental Policy

Whilst undertaking aviation retail logistics operations at our London Heathrow Consolidation Centre (HCC). Bradford Swissport Ltd is committed to the practice of sound environmental performance. This commitment includes compliance with the requirements of all relevant environmental legislation, company policies and procedures, as well as customer requirements. We will use all practicable means to prevent pollution and through measured continuous improvement we will achieve objectives and targets aimed at minimising the environmental impact of our operations.

In particular, working within the framework of the Bradford Swissport Ltd environmental management system and the ISO 14001 standard we strive to:

- Wholly support and comply with or exceed the requirements of current environmental legislation and codes of practice.
- Minimise our waste and then reuse or recycle as much of it as possible in line with the Hierarchy of Waste Controls.
- Minimise energy and water usage in our buildings, vehicles and processes in order to conserve supplies, and minimise our consumption of natural resources, especially where they are non-renewable.
- Operate and maintain company vehicles with due regard to environmental issues as far as reasonably practical and encourage the use of alternative means of fuel as appropriate.
